



How to delete D drive and extend C drive size in Windows 7?


1. Click on Start button and right click on Computer and then select Manage on the menu.




2. Click on Disk Management in the left pane of the Computer Management Window. You should be able to see the allocation status of the disk partition.




3. Right click on partition you want to delete. Choose Delete Volume. This will destroy all data on the selected partition, please back up them before continue.



4. Press Yes to continue the process.




5. Right click on C d and select Extend Volume.




6. Extend Volume Wizard will pop up, please press Next to continue.




7. Select available space and press Next to continue.



8. Press Finish to close the wizard.



9. Now you can see the C partition size is added.



P.S.1 Please be noticed that it is not recommended to delete Recovery Partition and Active partition or it may cause system crash or unable to do system recovery.

P.S.2 If you want to keep D drive and extend C drive size, you could use Shrink Volume to shrink D drive size and then extend the unallocated partition to C drive by using Extend Volume.
